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# AVOCADO EGG SALAD

2 Servings

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 4 hard boiled eggs, grated or finely chopped
- ½ ripe avocado, mashed
- ½ Tablespoon finely chopped dill pickle
- ½ Tablespoon chopped scallion, white part only
- ½ teaspoon ground pepper
- ½ teaspoon fine sea salt
- 1–2 Tablespoons fresh chopped parsley or dill, for garnish
- lettuce leaves, bread or crackers, for serving

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- **1. STIR:** Combine all ingredients in a bowl. Top with fresh herbs and serve.
- **2. STORE:** Store salad in an airtight container in the refrigerator. The salad will keep for 3–5 days. The avocado might brown a tiny bit, but it is still safe to eat.


#### NOTES


